INCENTIVE SCHEME FOR CERTIFICATION IN INFORMATION SYSTEM AUDITING (CISA-QUALIFICATION) FROM THE INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS AUDIT AND CONTROL ASSOCIATION (ISACA). USA

As a Supreme Audit Institute (SAI), the Department of Auditor General of Pakistan requires qualified auditors, in the field of Information System Auditing to effectively accomplish its mandate. Realizing the need of capacity building of employees in the field of IS Auditing, CISA Certification offered by the Institute of Information Systems Audit and Control Association (ISACA), USA is introduced as an incentive scheme to the officers of the Department of Auditor General of Pakistan (DAGP) for developing and Strengthening the skills in this particular area.

2. Finance Division vide its letter No. F.3(3)Exp-II/99/Vol-I/280 dated 29-03-2016 has approved the subject Incentive Scheme for five years w.e.f. March 29, 2016 with the concurrence of one-time reimbursement of ISACA Membership Fee, CISA Examination Fee and Study Material Cost at the following rates to the prospective officers of DAGP on successfully acquiring the certification.

a)	ISACA Membership Fee	US \$ 175/-
b)	CISA Exam Fee	US \$ 500/-
c)	Study Material Cost	US \$ 290/-
	Total per Candidate	US\$965/-

3. It is to be noted that the reimbursement for ISACA Membership & Exam Fee & Study Material Costs will be admissible only after the individual employee has successfully qualified the CISA Certification. Prior permission from the Departmental Head is necessary for the employees before Registration and taking up the examination.
