**Subject: HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME 2024**


The United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan (USEFP) has announced non-degree 10-12 months subject fellowship programme. The USEFP funds tuition, airfare, textbooks, a living stipend and health insurance and also assists with the visa process.

2. Flyer of the subject programme is attached with this circular. In addition to minimum 16 years education, at least five (05) years of experience alongwith Duolingo English Test score report is required. Officers/officials who fulfill the eligibility criteria for the programme and Criteria, circulated by this office vide letter No. Misc/DG-HRM/2020/137, dated 29.11.2021 (as amended from time to time) are encouraged to apply on below given **Form 1 at least 15 working days prior to closing date of 18.04.2023**. All the applications will be scrutinized by Scholarship Scrutiny Committee as per Eligibility Criteria referred to above. Therefore, the said criteria may be consulted before applying.

4. The concerned controlling office/Head of department may kindly ensure before recommending and forwarding of applications for NOC to apply that the same are complete in all respects.

5. It is clarified that subject fellowship is neither Pakistan-Specific nor DAGP - Specific. It is an open merit programme and this circular has been uploaded only for information/facilitation of the officers/officials.

The United States Educational Foundation in Pakistan (USEFP), a bi-national Commission, is pleased to announce the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program. This non-degree program is designed for mid-career (5-15 years of relevant experience) professionals and consists of 10-12 months of graduate-level, non-degree academic coursework and an opportunity to work in the United States in the relevant field. In addition to academic work, persons selected for this program are expected to share information about Pakistani life and culture with their U.S. colleagues and community groups in the United States. On returning to Pakistan, Humphrey grantees are expected to share their U.S. experience with colleagues and community groups in Pakistan. Successful candidates should be poised to assume leadership positions in their fields and must be committed to returning and serving Pakistan.

## GRANT BENEFITS

The grant funds tuition, airfare, living stipend, and health insurance. USEFP also assists with the visa process.

## ELIGIBILITY

Successful applicants must be Pakistani citizens residing and working in Pakistan, with a minimum of five years of progressively responsible professional/work experience, coupled with 16 years of formal education and a guarantee of re-employment upon return to Pakistan. Applicants must possess a high level of fluency in spoken and written English.

Applications will not be accepted from university teachers or researchers with no management experience or similar responsibilities, those who attended graduate school in the United States in the past seven years, or who have had long-term U.S. experience within the past five years. Also ineligible are persons with a dual U.S./Pakistan nationality or who have a spouse, fiancé, parent, or child over the age of 18 who is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Employees of the Fulbright organization, the U.S. Department of State or USAID, and their spouses, children, fiancés, siblings, dependents, and parents are also ineligible.
