To strengthen capacity of the supreme audit institutions (SAIs) and to support the enhancement of accountability and governance worldwide, the United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) has announced *International Auditor Fellowship Program-2020*. Content of the program includes classroom training, key management meetings observation, learning from US intergovernmental auditing experiences, and developing strategies for strengthening the fellow's respective SAIs based on information obtained during the program. The program continues from 18.03.2020 until 10.07.2020 with application submission deadline of 30.08.2019 for which participants are to be nominated by head of the SAI with the expectation that they will transfer the knowledge and skills gained during the program to their institutions.
