OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: OFFICERS OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WHILE POSTED IN THE PROVINCES TO ENSURE ADMINISTRATIVE NEUTRALITY AND RULE OF LAW IN THE RESPECTIVE PROVINCE

The undersigned is directed to state that the Prime Minister has taken serious notice of the tendency regarding the Officers, particularly the officers of Pakistan Administrative Service (PAS) and Police Service of Pakistan (PSP), while their posting in the Federal Departments who neither make sure their administrative duties with impartiality and observe the rules of law nor keep them away from the political activities, which is a hurdle in smooth running of the administrative affairs of the Federation.

Keeping in view above, all Federal Secretaries/ Additional Secretaries (Incharge) are requested to direct the Federal Government's Officers posted under their administrative control to ensure administrative neutrality and rule of law and strictly observe the provisions of Rules 24 and 29 of the Government Servants (Conduct) Rules, 1964 reproduced below:-

Rule-24. Taking part in politics and elections.- (1) No Government servant shall take part in subscribe in aid or assist in any way, any political movement in Pakistan or relating to the affairs of Pakistan.

(2) No Government servant shall permit any person dependent on him for maintenance or under his care or control to take part in or in any way assist, any movement or activity

which is, or tends directly or indirectly to be, subversive of Government as by law established in Pakistan.

(3) No Government servant shall canvass or otherwise interfere or use his influence in connection with or take part in any election to a legislative body, whether in Pakistan or elsewhere:

Provided that a Government servant who is qualified to vote at such election may exercise his right to vote: but if he does so, he shall give no indication of the manner in which he propose to vote or has voted.

(4) No Government servant shall allow any member of his family dependent on him to indulge in any political activity, including forming a political association and being its member, or to act in a manner in which he himself is not permitted by sub-rule (3) to act.


(5) A government servant who issues an address to electors or in any other manner publicly announces himself or allows himself to be publicly as a candidate or prospective candidate for election to a legislative body shall be deemed for the purpose of sub-rule (3) to take part in an election to such body.

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(7) to local authorities or bodies, save in respect of Government servants required or permitted by or under any law, or order of the Government, for the time being in force, to be candidates at such elections.

(7) If any question arises whether any movement or activity falls with scope of this rule, the decision of the Government thereon shall be final.

Rule-29. Use of political or other influence.- No Government servant shall bring or attempt to bring political or other outside influence, directly or indirectly, to bear on the Government or any Government servant in support of any claim arising in connection with his employment as such.

3. The above instructions may be circulated among the departments/ offices/ organizations/ statutory bodies under their administrative control directing the Officers to adhere to the same in letter and spirit.
