## Circular

Subject: **Issuance of NOC While Applying for Government of Pakistan Positions Abroad**

Grant of No Objection Certificate (NOC) for applying for duly advertised/circulated Government of Pakistan positions abroad like Community Welfare Attaché, Commercial Attaché, Economic Minister, and others is one of the mandates of this Section. At the HRM Section, each individual case for grant of NOC requires a minimum processing time for detailed examination and review vis-à-vis the laid down policy and procedure besides coordination and internal correspondence for the required input from the Confidential Section, Legal Section, and others.

2. It has however been observed that most of the time the aspirants start forwarding requests for grant of NOCs very close to the submission deadlines thereby creating an unwarranted hustle for processing their cases that ultimately leads to compromised quality and delayed output. Recognising the timelines in such cases and to streamline the system, it has been decided that the HRM Section will take a reasonable time of at least 14 days to decide requests for grant of NOC for the advertised/circulated Government of Pakistan positions abroad.

3. All concerned are informed and requested to adhere to the above timelines.
