Interested IDC and DC officers of BS-17 and above (DC officers posted in field audit offices/PAAA/PAW/OAGP only) who are eligible as per criteria mentioned above are requested to forward their applications to HR Wing latest by **05.06.2026 (Friday)** via e-office through their controlling officers along with above referred documents for grant of No Objection Certificate to apply and forward nominations to EAD

3. IDC officers posted under CGA and MAG offices shall route their applications through Office of the CGA and Office of the MAG respectively for submission to this office

## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT: MINISTERIAL SEMINAR ON JOINT PURSUIT OF MODERNIZATION FOR GLOBAL SOUTH COUNTRIES FROM 2ND JULY TO 11 JULY, 2026 (2 SLOTS)**

The undersigned is directed to state that the Government of the People's Republic of China has offered subject ministerial Seminar for officers of the Government of Pakistan ([Details attached](#)). The Chinese side has further informed that the candidates **cannot be withdrawn once nominated**. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable to bear any cost. The requisite general requirements are as under:

### Eligibility Criteria

- Officers (**BS-17 & above**) of Ministries/ Divisions and Provincial Governments, most relevant to the training programme;
- Proficiency in English;
- **Under 50 for officials at director general's level and under 45 for officials at or under director's level;**
- **Contract Employees are not eligible.**

### Documents Required

The following documents are required to be sent along with the nomination:

- Application Form with personal signature and photo (**Original & Copy**);
- Information Form with personal signature and photo (**Original & Copy**);
- Copy of Passport with at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages;
- Foreigner Physical Examination Form with personal photo (**Original & Copy**);
- No criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate attested (Apostille) by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, if not visited China within last 5 years;
- FTC Proforma;
- Copy of CNIC;
- Surety Bond on stamp paper (**Original**);
- Undertaking on stamp paper (**Original**);
- No Objection Certificate.

2. Nominations of suitable candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria, duly approved by the competent authority, may be forwarded to this Ministry by **June 08, 2026 positively**. All Ministries / Divisions / Attached Departments and Provincial P & D Departments must note the following points while nominating the candidates:

1. Most relevant candidates should be nominated for the training program.

2. Nomination of candidates should reach EAD before the deadline. Late arrival of nomination, after EAD's deadline, will not be entertained.
3. Nomination papers, complete in all respects, should be forwarded to EAD through proper channel i.e. through the respective Administrative Ministry / Division/ P&D Department.
4. All candidates must follow the code of conduct ([Annex-I](#)).

The GDI is China's first global initiative focusing on development, which was proposed based on the current international situation and China's development experience. It is a public good open to the whole world.</p> <p>South-South cooperation is a vital form of mutual support among Global South Countries, strengthening international economic collaboration and advancing sustainable development goals. It plays a pivotal role in fostering socio-economic progress across the Global South Countries. The deepening South-South cooperation among Global South Countries, characterized by mutual learning and assistance in poverty reduction and development, mutual solidarity and support on the international political stage, and collective advancement toward modernization and group rise, stands as a defining feature of the great global transformation and an unprecedented feat in the progress of human civilization.</p> <p>Purpose: This seminar aims to share China's experience in <u>modernization construction</u> with government officials from Global South Countries, to provide them with lessons for reference. It also encourages these countries to work together, with the spirit of "global solidarity", to uphold fair governance, and maintain world peace and stability; to adhere to win-win cooperation and promote global sustainable development; to embrace inclusiveness and mutual learning, and build a community of shared future for mankind. Simultaneously, it seeks to establish a ministerial-level exchange platform between China and Global South Countries to facilitate policy coordination and mutual learning among civilizations.</p> <p>Content: The seminar lectures will primarily cover: an overview of China's national conditions and <u>Chinese modernization</u>, the <u>governance philosophy of Chinese leadership</u>, the Global Development Initiative and South-South cooperation, <u>China's poverty alleviation policies and rural revitalization</u>, <u>China's green development</u>, as well as the modernization of <u>national governance capacity and systems</u>, etc.</p> <p>Method: Invite experts in relevant fields to give lectures on specific topics; organize discussions and exchanges between students and experts, as well as among students; and organize students to visit and exchange ideas with relevant institutions and companies in Beijing and other cities.</p>

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## CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Adhere to the laws of the People's Republic of China and the relevant regulations outlined in the relevant seminar / training.
2. While the Chinese government upholds the freedom of religion, it is important to note that foreigners are prohibited from distributing religious propaganda material or engaging in activities that aim to recruit followers.
3. In case of an emergency, please promptly inform the staff for immediate assistance.
4. Please ensure the safety of your personal belongings and consider storing them in the hotel if needed.
5. If you have any specific dietary requirements, kindly inform the staff as soon as possible.
6. When visiting scenic spots and historical sites, please be attentive to signs indicating that photography is not allowed.
7. Please observe Chinese laws and Regulations during your stay. Especially the norms of “sexual harassment” can be different from your country’s. Please avoid inappropriate and undesirable situations, which can lead to the termination of your program and draw legal consequences. Acts, conversation, correspondence, emails, gestures that can be construed as harassment must be strictly avoided.
8. You are not allowed to work, because you receive living allowance from China and the purpose of your stay in China is to engage in study / research.
9. Universally courtesy and politeness costs nothing and only earn friends. It is always beneficial to be courteous and polite. Politeness is not a sign of weakness. It shows good breeding, education and upbringing.
10. Female colleagues must be respected. They are fellow officers. Some very basic things shall be considered while interacting with the female colleagues:
  - Generally, as a mark of respect, one should stand when a female enters a room.
  - Personal space should be respected during conversation and a comfortable distance should be maintained.
  - Personal remarks on their dress and appearance should be avoided.
  - Loose language or inappropriate terms should not be used.
  - Inappropriate jokes should not be cracked.

- Hand gestures universally deemed obscene should not be made.
- Staring should be strictly avoided.
- Situations that make female colleagues uncomfortable should be avoided.
- While talking to a female, hands should never be placed in trousers pockets.
- Personal questions should never be asked (age, height, weight, marital status etc).
- Ordinarily, men should open the door for women.
- Females should always precede a male while entering a room.
- Door of a car should be opened for a female colleague.

11. Psychological harassment is against Chinese norms, that shall strictly be avoided:

- a. Persistent, unjustified and unnecessary negative attacks on personal or professional performance;
- b. Manipulation of an employee's personal or professional reputation by rumor, gossip or ridicule;
- c. Offensive comments or behavior relating to the ethnic origin, physical characteristics or religion of an individual;
- d. Exclusion or continued isolation from professional activities;

12. Social media ethics ought to be adhered to with responsibility.
