**SUBJECT: NOMINATION OF OFFICERS FOR TRAININGS COURSES AT PAAA AND PAW LAHORE**

It has been observed with concern that, in certain instances, officers nominated for short courses at PAAA and PAW do not attend the said training programmes without prior intimation, submission of cogent reasons, and/or obtaining approval of the competent authority. Such conduct is inconsistent with the established norms of institutional discipline and administrative propriety. It also results in sub-optimal utilization of training resources and adversely impacts the Department's overall capacity-building efforts.

2. In view of the foregoing, all field offices are hereby requested to issue strict instructions to all PA&AS officers under their administrative control to ensure mandatory attendance in training programmes for which they are duly nominated. Non-attendance, except in cases of unavoidable circumstances and with prior approval of the competent authority, shall be viewed seriously.

3. It is further emphasized that any request for exemption from a nominated training programme must be supported by adequate justification and submitted well in advance for consideration and approval by the competent authority

4. It is also hereby informed that, henceforth, a consolidated list of PA&AS officers who, despite being formally nominated, fail to attend any training programme or course—along with the reasons for such non-attendance—shall be submitted on a regular basis to the worthy Auditor-General of Pakistan for perusal and appropriate decision.
